

WRITING #4 - MRS. C'S ENGLISH

EXPAND A QUICKWRITE (AGAIN)

1. Take a look at the quickwrites in your writer's notebook. (There will be at least 29 by the time this assignment is due.)
2. Revisit the topics if needed by using the "English 9/10 Notebook Checklist" tab on the mrsconnollysclass.com site.
3. Choose any one of them to expand into a bigger piece (about a page typed in a reasonable/default font size).
 - Your piece could read like a story, or like a letter, or like an exploratory essay (doesn't need a 5 paragraph format; just paragraph where the ideas shift).
 - Don't go over a page – yes, you can double-space (but don't use a font bigger than the default).
 - Please indicate which quickwrite # was the starter or inspiration for your writing AND give your work an *actual* title that reflects the writing instead of just labeling it. (e.g. "The Truth about Reality" instead of "Quickwrite #4")
 - **MOST IMPORTANT: Your thinking needs to be YOURS!! Do not google info just to copy and paste here. It's about YOUR Ideas.**
 - **NEW: This piece CAN'T be the same as Writing #2: Pick a different writing to expand.**

Tech Steps:

1. Use Google docs to start a new document. Do this through GClassroom by going through the classwork tab and this assignment – then, it will appear where it should.
2. Name it YourLastName Writing 4 (not literally – replace that with YOUR last name).
3. Just use a regular font size (the default is good). Please set the spacing to double.
4. Write your one-page commentary. Be sure to shift paragraphs where ideas shift.
