SELECTING YOUR LYRICS FOR

WRITING #6 - HIP-HOP/RAP ANALYSIS

Choose a text for analysis – be sure to know who **WROTE** it/should be the artist (or one of them if in a group)

- 1. Find a rap/hip-hop song that is word-filled and text-rich
- 2. Listen to it LOTS of times *watch the video if you want
- 3. Locate the lyrics get really familiar with them
- Be sure to pick a text that "says something" something meaningful NOT just something obscene
- 5. You do not have to censor profanity from your lyrics but can if you prefer

Tech Steps:

- 1. Open your Dropbox and go to your DRAFTS folder.
- 2. Choose CREATE NEW FILE & start a new WORD document.
- 3. Open another tab and Google your lyrics
- 4. Copy (highlight the text and ctrl+c) the lyrics
- 5. Return to your Word doc and Paste (ctrl+v) the lyrics onto the page
- 6. If the chorus of the song repeats itself a lot of times, you can delete a few of them
- 7. It is also okay to adjust the spacing to make it fit on the page better (but keep it looking like poetry rather than prose)
- 8. Make sure the name of the song and artist/writer is at the top of your page
- 9. Title the doc YourlastnameLyrics(not literally replace that with YOUR last name)
- 10. Leave this doc in your Drafts folder we will be working with them IN CLASS
- 11. DO NOT share the document. I already have access to your folders so that is an unnecessary step.
